The Steacie Prize in the Natural Sciences

The Steacie Prize is a Canadian award of \$10,000 presented once a year to a scientist or engineer of 40 years of age or less for outstanding scientific research carried out in Canada. To compete for this prize, a person must be nominated by a colleague. The winner is selected by a distinguished panel appointed annually by the E.W.R. Steacie Memorial Fund, a private foundation dedicated to the advancement of science and engineering in Canada.

Nominations require: an introductory letter explaining why the candidate should be considered for the prize, including the candidate's year of birth; a *curriculum vitae* with publication list; and names and addresses (including e-mail) of 5 expert external referees. Nominations longer than 25 pages (single-sided) may be edited. Submissions should be made by e-mail (*.doc and/or *.pdf files). The deadline for receipt is **June 30, 2018**.
